Edward Wilkens Scholarship Fund

PURPOSE

The intent of the Edward Wilkens Scholarship Fund is to assist high school graduates in Baltimore City and surrounding counties to obtain a college education at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore. Funds are limited to undergraduates attending UMES in Princess Anne, Maryland. The scholarships are \$500 per semester for full time students. The UMES Alumni Association Baltimore Chapter, on behalf of the Edward Wilkens Scholarship Fund, will disperse these awards.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be a senior, graduating from a Baltimore area high school
2. Applicant must be accepted and plan to attend the University of Maryland Eastern Shore
3. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average or better, grade point average.
4. Applicant must show proof of registration for the first semester of the current academic year before monies are dispersed.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the application and write a brief essay explaining why you want to attend the University of Maryland Eastern Shore.
2. Submit two letters of recommendation; one from an educator
3. Have your guidance counselor certify your scholastic qualifications and provide a copy of your transcript.
